***"Teaching the Science in Everyday Life"***

The University of Arkansas GK12 program pairs fellows (graduate students) in Physics, Chemistry, and Engineering with middle school math and science teachers to develop and implement inquiry based modules. This year, the program is teaming with the College of Education to offer a paid adventure into the inquiry process for science and math MAT students. The workshop is one month long and divided into four stages. Those stages include (1) Introduction to Arkansas State Standards and the inquiry process, (2) Two day team building summer camp, (3) The development of inquiry science and math modules to be used in the summer camp for middle school students, and (4) A one week science summer camp for middle school students.
