"Teaching the Science in Everyday Life"

The University of Arkansas is offering a unique opportunity for 6th and 7th grade science and math teachers in Northwest Arkansas school districts to have a "visiting scientist" in their classroom. Teachers, selected as science-math teams, will be paired with graduate students in Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Engineering, and Microelectronics-Photonics for a year-long partnership in teaching the everyday applications of science and math. Graduate students and teachers will team together to develop and teach units that integrate concepts across the curriculum from Arkansas Science and Math Frameworks. The grant includes a budget for laboratory equipment and materials. Both teachers and fellows will receive extensive training in the summer of 2009.
